When the Beeches introduced the signature Staggerwing, a Beechcraft® Model 17 biplane, it immediately became an important and innovative part of the war effort. By 1937, the monoplane twin Beechcraft® Model 18 was essential to allied air forces as a military transport, bomber and training aircraft.

The Beech family were not only iconic manufacturers, but trailblazing business leaders. When Walter Beech fell ill, Olive Ann took control of the company and oversaw an increase of defense orders from 235 to more than 4,000 in just three years. Upon Walter Beech’s death in 1950, Olive Ann Beech became one of the first female CEOs in America.
